





Pistachio Mallow Salad-perfect for family night or serve with your friends!! And Yummy!

- 1 carton (16 ounces) whipped topping
- 1 package (3.4 ounces) instant pistachio pudding mix
- 6 to 7 drops green food coloring, optional
- 3 cups miniature marshmallows
- 1 can (20 ounces) pineapple tidbits, undrained
- 1/2 cup chopped pistachios or walnuts
- Additional whipped topping, optional

· In a large bowl, combine whipped topping, pudding mix and food coloring if desired. Fold in the marshmallows and pineapple. Cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hours. Just before serving, top with additional whipped topping if desired, sprinkle with nuts.

Shamrock pretzels are a fast and easy St. Patrick's Day candy recipe. This one is perfect for kids to help with! All you need are pretzels, green candy coating, and the patience to arrange them into shamrock shapes.

Ingredients

- 12 ounces green candy coating
- 90 mini twist pretzels (3 to 4 cups)

Steps to Make It

- · Gather the ingredients.
- · Place the green candy coating in a microwave-safe bowl. Microwave in 30-second increments, stirring well after every 30 seconds, until the coating is melted and smooth.
- Cover several baking sheets with waxed paper or
- Dunk a pretzel in the melted coating until it's completely covered. Take it out of the coating using a fork or dipping tools, and let the excess drip back into the bowl for a few minutes.
- Place the pretzel on the baking sheet. Repeat with a second pretzel, and when you place it on the baking sheet, position it so that the bottom of the second pretzel is touching the bottom of the first.
- Repeat a third time, and this time, place the pretzel at the top of the other two so that they form a shamrock shape.
- Break a pretzel twist in pieces, so that you have a few short segments that can be the stems. Dip one stem piece in the coating, then position it at the bottom of the shamrock.
- Dip a small spoon or fork in the coating, and use it to add a dollop of coating in the center of the shamrock, just so that it has a smooth, even surface.
- Repeat with the remaining pretzels and coating, until you've made 24 shamrock shapes.
- · Refrigerate the trays to set the shamrocks, for about 15 minutes.
- · When set, use a paring knife to trim away any stray coating from the edges of the shamrocks.
- Serve immediately and enjoy!

Costa Rica - Pura Vida

I was fortunate enough to spend the week of New Year's in Costa Rica. Costa Rican people really embody "Pura Vida," aka the pure life. The whole Costa Rican ethos revolves around the idea of enjoying a simple life.


If you want to visit Costa Rica, I would definitely recommend a split stay. Many people do not realize how large Costa Rica really is and traveling between destinations can easily take a whole day.

So, what is there to do in this double-coasted Central American country? If you are just looking for an ultra-relaxed beach vacation, Costa Rica might not be the right destination for you, because there is so much more to do in Costa Rica than water and beach life.

Monteverde and Santa Elena in the northern part of Costa Rica are great for trekking at high altitude. In the northwestern part of the country, you can see Arenal Volcano National Park and indulge in the area's many hot springs (as well as enjoy the rush of ziplining over the rainforest!). On the Central Pacific Coast, you'll find white sand beaches bordering lush tropical forest inside Manuel Antonio National Park. The small park is filled with a dizzying array of monkeys, birds, and—everybody's favorite—the sloth.

Then there is Tortuguero National Park, located in the Limón Province of Costa Rica's Caribbean coast. It is located in an elaborate network of narrow canals that wind their way through pristine jungle and coastal wetlands. From the safety and comfort of your own canoe, you can paddle along these shrouded waterways all day in search of hidden wildlife.

And, of course, there are Costa Rica's popular Pacific Coast beach towns: Tamarindo, Uvita, Puerto Viejo, Jacos, the region of Guanacaste, and the Gulf of Papagayo. Some are dotted with black sand beaches and others, like Playa Conchal and



Playa Flamingo, are famed for their glistening white sand. An all-day catamaran trip that takes you to a variety of different beaches will give you just a glimpse of the different flora and fauna and allows for exploring, snorkeling, and sunbathing.

If you plan to do a split say, I recommend at least a week to 10 days in the country. Fly into San Jose, then head to Tortuguero, the remote national park about three hours away and accessible only by boat or plane. Two days are not much in the area but just enough to get an idea of the rich wildlife and vegetation.

Then head to Arenal. It's about a five-hour drive from Tortuguero. Plan on at least three days in Arenal to trek the volcano, zipline, hike La Fortuna waterfall, and take an aerial tram. Don't forget to take a dip in one of the many hot springs! Your last stop should be a resort on the Pacific Coast for some much-needed relaxation after all the physical exertion of the last week. Tamarindo is known to be a hot surfing spot but also has excellent snorkeling. The closest airport to the Tamarindo area is Liberia International, about 90 minutes away.



BW: How it's all about our neighborhood!



HBL- Future events or specials planned?






