



## **New 2020 Coastal Flood Maps**

In 2019 FEMA announced new Coastal Flood Insurance Rate Maps. Many properties have been moved into lower risk flood zones and/or the Base Flood Elevation (the elevation where there is a 1% or greater annual chance of flooding) will be reduced. However, there will be some areas where homes are moved into higher risk flood zones and/or the BFE will be increasing. Check the website below to see if the new maps will affect your property:

If you see that your flood risk is going to change with these new maps — don't panic! There are many solutions and options available, even if you are being moved to a higher risk flood zone.





She has been so strong and fearless through it all. I admire her courage and strength!

HBL-Poor little girl but what a trooper. I have to meet her!!

HBL-What do you like best about your pet? AB-Stella and I have a special bond. It's almost as if she can read my mind. She can sense when I'm tired, stressed, upset, or just need her to snuggle me. It doesn't hurt that she shares a love of all of the finer things in life, especially charcuterie!

HBL-Any funny stories? AB-It seems that Stella is always doing something silly. She finds herself stuck between the dining room table legs. She attempted to break out of the back yard by digging her way underneath the fence. She must have gotten scared after venturing into the neighborhood, because after a 30-minute panic reaction from her parents, Stella was found at home, waiting by the front door.

HBL-How spoiled is your pet? AB-Stella is given fresh, filtered water almost hourly. ## ON BOARD THE INAUGURAL SAILING OF NORWEGIAN'S NEWEST SHIP, THE ENCORE

This past November I was invited to attend the inaugural sailing of Norwegian's newest, fourth and final vessel in the fleet's acclaimed Breakaway Plus Class: Norwegian Encore.

On a rather chilly Monday morning, we set sail from Miami. First impression: from the outside, the ship is as dazzling as the bright, abstract hull art designed by Spanish artist Eduardo Arranz-Bravo.

Check-in and luggage drop off took us less than 10 minutes.

From the moment we stepped on board, Norwegian Encore impressed: whether with the world's longest race track at sea, or the largest outdoor laser tag arena, the Galaxy Pavilion, the sleek and modern design, this ship just feels a little, well, special. Tiny shoals of fish on the stateroom level carpets guided us forward,
















and digital touchscreens dotted about the ship allowed us to do just about everything from booking dining, to arrange for a Swedish massage and to reserve

seats for the shows. It was a pleasure to experience the shows: Choir of Man and Kinky Boots both outstanding and entertaining performances. Worth mentioning is also Prohibition The Musical, which entertains with a one-of-akind interactive experience. Once we stepped through the doors, we were transported to the eve of Prohibition, right down to the special prohibition-era drinks, served generously throughout the performance. Talking about feasts! I am a bit of a picky eater but the seafood buffet blew me away. Alaskan King crab legs, stone crabs, oysters, shrimps, and clams were just a few of the delectable items. Also worth mentioning is Onda by Scarpetta, a classic approach to old-world Italian fare and Food Republic with exceptionally fine Asian cuisine. At the heart of the dining is the big, busy Garden Café which is buffet-style so one can choose whatever one likes. There's a huge selection here so there really is something for every taste and dietary requirement and you can get something to eat at any time of day. The decoration is neutral tasteful and I liked that it was divided into different areas, making it less of a buffet-style restaurant and more intimate. All over, I think Norwegian Encore is my newest favorite cruise ship (and the Galaxy Pavilion my newest obsession). With so much to do, especially for families, it'll be a cruise you won't soon forget.





# Noodle Salad

## GLUTEN-FREE, GRAIN-FREE AND DAIRY FREE

#### ASIAN NOODLE SALAD

Serves 6

This is a light veggie-packed salad that is made with sweet potato glass noodles (made with sweet potato starch and water). They can be ordered on-line or found at your local Asian Market. It is delicious by itself or with your favorite salad topper.



#### Gluten-free, grain-free and dairy-free.

½ package sweet potato noodles (approximately 12 oz)

4 cups shredded Napa cabbage

1 cup shredded carrots

½ cup Julienned red onions

¼ cup chopped basil

1/4 cup chopped cilantro

1/4 cup chopped green onions (green tops only)

Toasted sesame seeds for garnish

Cook sweet potato noodles per package instructions. Allow to chill before adding veggie ingredients. Mix well. When ready to serve, mix with dressing and garnish with toasted sesame seeds if desired.

#### **DRESSING**

3 cloves garlic - rough chopped 1 bunch of cilantro 1/8th cup fresh ginger –peeled and diced ½ cup chopped basil 1/3 cup rice vinegar 1/4 cup green onion 34 cup toasted sesame oil ½ cup Tamari

To make dressing blend all the ingredients except sesame oil in blender. When well blended, turn to medium speed and slowly stream in the sesame oil until emulsified.







#### "YOU HAVE CANCER"

Have you ever had that sentence said to you? Or a loved one? How did you react? What can you do to help? When someone is diagnosed with cancer, his or her world is turned upside -down. The entire family is affected.

So if you are the patient and seeing your physician for a discussion of his diagnosis, there are important things to consider. Be sure to ask questions even if you think the questions are trivial; you are there to use his expertise. You are going to be spending time and relying on him and his team, so you must have very positive feelings towards his knowledge. He/she needs to spend as much time with you as you need. Make sure you have another set of ears to remember what he says. Record the conversation if need be. Your caregiver will need to be informed about everything you will be experiencing.

There are no stupid questions. Find out what your diagnosis is and what stage it is. Ask if it is genetic or environmental. How long have I had the cancer; is it slow-growing or fast? Find out

about your treatments/drugs. What will be the long or short term effects of the drugs? Is this curative or palliative?

Ask about diet and medical tests; get references and second opinions; discuss costs and payments.
