nails done, Home Depot, Wilcox nursery, and, of course, pet supermarket.


Do I snore? No, of course, not.



One Pot Garlic Butter CHICKEN THIGHS AND

Mushrooms

PREP TIME: 5 MINUTES COOK TIME: 20 MINUTES TOTAL TIME: 25 MINUTES

resident recipe

INGREDIENTS

- · 4 tbsp butter, divided
- PINCH of salt, very small amount but if using low sodium stock or unsalted butter, ok to use a little more salt
- · 4 chicken thighs, bones removed (skinless or with skin OK)
- 6-10 cloves garlic, sliced in half or finely diced (I like big chunks of garlic but realize most don't)
- · 8 oz cremini mushrooms, stems removed and wiped clean
- · 1 cup chicken stock
- 1 pinch to 1 tsp red pepper flakes, depending on your desired spicy level
- 1/2 cup diced cilantro, optional
- · 2 tbsp lemon juice
- 1/4 cup parmesan cheese

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Heat a heavy pan on medium-high until very hot.
- 2. Add butter, swirl around the pan, and let melt.
- 3. When butter is foamy and melted, add chicken thighs.
- Very lightly salt chicken thighs (ONE pinch for all things don't overdo it!)
- 5. Cook chicken thighs for 5 minutes on each side, until lovely golden brown.
- 6. When chicken thighs are well browned, remove from pan-do not drain pan grease.
- 7. Add garlic to the pan, stir well.
- 8. Add mushrooms to the pan, stirring occasionally to keep mushrooms and garlic from burning.
- 9. Add the second half of butter to the pan, let melt.
- 10. Let garlic and mushrooms brown about 4-6 minutes. Do not let the garlic burn, reduce heat if needed.
- 11. Add red pepper flakes (add slowly according to your taste) and cilantro when chicken and mushrooms are lovely golden browned.
- 12. Add stock, lemon juice, and cheese.
- 13. Stir well, being sure to scrape up any browned bits from the bottom of the pan.
- 14. Bring to a boil, let reduce and thicken slightly for 2 minutes.
- 15. Add chicken thighs back to the pan, let the sauce reduce another 5-8 minutes, flipping chicken occasionally until thick and chicken thighs reach 165 internal temp.
- 16. Remove from pan and serve immediately!

Maui is an extremely popular destination with travelers all across the US, so when Governor David Ige opened up travel to Maui in October again, I knew I had to pay a visit to check out how travel to Hawaii has changed post-Covid. Currently, US travelers to Maui have to provide proof of a negative Covid test taken within 72 hours of departure time of your flight from the mainland to the island. In addition, travelers have to fill out an online travel authorization form that includes uploading your test results.

One of the more complex requirements for any travel these days is the proof of a valid, negative Covid test. The Hawaii travel authorization website has a list of approved medical facilities that can provide timely testing.

I had been in Aruba the days leading up to my departure, so for this trip, I decided to take advantage of the United same-day testing facilities located at San Francisco airport. We had to schedule an appointment in advance for this test $% \left\{ 1,2,...,2,...\right\}$ and it is recommended you do it more than 3 hours before your departure. It was a very quick and well-organized testing site and we actually received our negative results within 12 minutes of taking the test.

Our nonstop flights landed in Maui at 10.05 pm. We were able to complete the health check, present all supporting documents, and get our luggage within 30 minutes of arriving.

Maui is breathtaking and a true paradise for lovers! One of my favorite benefits of traveling during these times is that most destinations are way below capacity and that was certainly evident in Maui.

Hawaii is extremely strict with Covid safety protocols. Masks are required in public spaces at all times, unless you are stationary, like sitting in a restaurant or in a beach chair. There are hefty fines to be paid if you are found to be without a mask. We stayed in Kihei, at a private condo, with a breathtaking view of the ocean, and had rented a car.

During one of our excursions, we ventured out to the Road to Hana. The Road to Hana is only 52 miles but the average speed 25 mph. It is known as Divorce Highway. It has 617 turns and 59 bridges, many only 1 lane. It travels along the edge of many sheer cliffs. The road starts in Kahului and ends in Hana. It is the longest rainforest highway in the USA.

Another excursion was the summit of Haleakala, the highest elevation on Maui. Being up with the rising sun makes you feel like you are all alone in the world, I highly recommend this trip. And those of you who are more adventurous, you can even hike down the crater, about two miles and I can promise you it's an experience like no other. More of a biker? You can rent a bike and transfer up to the summit and then ride the way down from the summit. Make sure your brakes are in perfect working order! As I mentioned before, Maui is currently at a much lower capacity with visitors and there were very few cars traveling with us, making the whole experience even more magical and removed. The pictures certainly don't do it justice!

All information was current at the time of writing this article, but as we know, protocols change daily so be sure to talk to a trusted travel agent before booking any vacation. A good advisor will keep you up to date on current protocols to ensure you will have the vacation of a lifetime, even in Covid times.


We look forward to wearing our goofy hats and waking up early to get in some exercise before the day of eating begins.

While we can't be together in person this year, the need to support housing and homelessness has never been greater.

The 2021 Blue Jean Ball Committee is continuing our mission to support Religious Community Services (now known as Hope Villages of America) during this unprecedented time of COVID-19. While we are not able to host our

traditional party, we are continuing our fundraising efforts through directed giving and an online auction.

For more than 50 years RCS (Hope Villages of America) has been dedicated to improving and saving lives in Pinellas County through programs and services that address hunger, homelessness, and domestic abuse.

In one year, RCS:

- Feeds 70,000 people through their Food Bank
- Distributes 4,000,000 pounds of food through their Food Bank
- Assists with 4,000 domestic abuse calls through The Haven
- Houses 550 families at Grace House






HBL – What has launching this first collection taught you?





It all started when I was 15. My father (Air Force Colonel) had been posted to a diplomatic assignment in Helsinki, Finland. Very few teens had cars in mid-1950s Finland, so I spent a lot of time riding on the back of friends' scooters and mopeds. One day, my friend gave me the keys to his scooter and let me take it for a spin. I was hesitant at first, starting out on the paved road, but soon felt comfortable; it was intoxicating. When I turned onto a gravel side road I lost control and down we went. The resulting bloody hand and scratched scooter might have been a deterrent for some but for me, the infection had already set in. I had the "motorcycle disease," and it's been a lifelong illness.



My father was away fighting WWII when I was born in January 1943, so we didn't meet until I was a year-and-a-half old. The military lifestyle (moving across the country every few years) was more of an education for me than school. In Nebraska I got my first gun—a 22 rifle, but I wasn't really a hunter. In Rhode Island I learned how to sail, something I've enjoyed the rest of my life. In Florida and Louisiana, days were spent catching blue crabs. After attending nine different schools in different states and countries, I managed to graduate from JEB Stuart High School in Falls Church, Virginia to the surprise and delight of my family. In 1963 I moved to Florida to attend St. Petersburg Jr. College.

Motorcycles had been put on the back burner for a few years, but in the early '70s, the Japanese motorcycle companies were offering high quality, small bikes at reasonable prices and I couldn't resist; I bought a dirt bike. Four years later, I parked the dirt bike and bought a Hobie Cat, for more family-friendly recreation. The boat was fun but I missed motorcycling and just didn't have the time or money to do both...unless I sold my car. So in 1977 I sold my car and bought a Honda street bike that became my daily transportation.

In 1992, I got a call from Ray Hempstead (owner of Barney's motorcycles in St. Pete). He was given my name by a mutual

friend who vouched I could both ride and sell. He hired me for a temporary three-month sales job; I retired from Barney's 25 years later. My "dream job" had found me. I was general manager when Barney's was struck by lightning and burned down in 2000. How we rebuilt from the ashes is a story in itself, but our accomplishments as a team were amazing and a highlight of my life.

My love of motorcycles has taken me all over the country, introduced me to great people, and opened the door to many unusual experiences. I remember coming upon a tarantula migration in the middle of Texas. Thousands of the large, black spiders were crossing the road for miles; we had to weave through the mass trying to avoid as many as we could. Camping in the desert at night is an amazing light show of the milky way and shooting stars. Leaning into the wind, smelling the smells, feeling the temperature while your mind constantly balances the forces of gravity, centrifugal force, power application and traction...to this day it's still intoxicating.



In my new season of being single, I'll leave you with this prayer/poem written by anonymous.


Single Woman's Poem

If you had quizzed me this time two years ago on where I thought I'd be right now, the Gulf Coast probably wouldn't have been my first — or fifth — guess.

In early 2019, I was toiling away as a senior editor at Denver's city magazine, 5280. I loved my job — I started as an intern in 2013 and often quip that I got

my dream job right out of college — but over time, the daily grind wore on me. My desk slowly acquired magnets and postcards that said things like "If Not Now, Then When?" and "The Journey Is the Destination." I devoured travel-minded books like Wild and To Shake the Sleeping Self, and it wasn't unusual for me to lay awake at night researching far away places (most notably, the Atacama Desert in Chile). Clearly, my #wanderlust was getting the best of me. I knew something inside me was stirring, but I didn't know toward what — or where — it would propel me.

Finally, in July 2019, for no reason in particular other than that my apartment lease was up and there was no promotion on my immediate horizon, I resigned. I wasn't sure what I was going to do, but it wouldn't be sitting at a desk for eight hours a day. Over the course of a few weeks, I swiftly quit not just my job of nearly seven years, but my life as it were: I sold or gave away nearly all my belongings, one-by-one. I wrote dozens of goodbye/thank you letters. I held a large, boozy goodbye dinner at one of my favorite neighborhood restaurants (don't you miss those?). I packed up what was left of my stuff and shipped it to my mom's address in Indian Rocks Beach, where she and her husband had relocated from Arizona just two months prior. Alas, on August 3 — four days before my 30th birthday — my dog, Luna, and I got in my blue Subaru and started the 1,900-mile trek from the Mile High City to the Gulf Coast of Florida. I waved goodbye to my life in Colorado. The Rocky Mountains were, literally, in my rearview mirror.

I had previously visited the Sunshine State exactly three times in my life (Once as a baby, does that even count?). But when in doubt, you go to mom's house. It's not so much that I didn't have a plan; it's that my plan was to take a little break — a sabbatical you might say — to spend time with family and do a little traveling. Newly surrounded by family members between 60 and 80 years old, my sabbatical turned into a sort of "taste of retirement." And it was glorious: I spent afternoons drinking poolside cocktails with my aunt in Harbor Bluffs; I took near-daily naps (a habit I shamelessly continue to this day); and, at least four times a week, I was beachbound. Staying in my mother's guest bedroom at 30 wasn't exactly in my life plan, but it sure as hell didn't suck.





I also finally took that trip to northern Chile's Atacama Desert. After six weeks in South America, I returned in mid-November full of empanadas, cheap Latin beer, and gratitude. After a cumulative four months of "retirement," I started to look for work. I think I'm one of the lucky ones because, within about a month, I landed an editorial writing contract. I never envisioned myself becoming a freelancer or self-employed, but that's what has transpired. A year has passed since that first contract offer, and I'm now a full-fledged contractor with an LLC who is happily juggling varied digital communications, writing, and editing gigs (hi, HBL fam!). It has been a pleasant surprise, to say the least.

Though flipping the table on my steady nine-to-five seemed a somewhat impractical decision at best, it was an undeniably fortuitous one. I ended up being perfectly poised to confront COVID-19: I was already working from home with a flexible schedule, close to family and, frankly, had basically zero friends here to socialize with anyhow. Though I had to give up my "digital nomad" dream of working-while-traveling in 2020, COVID's isolating orders brought in a different kind of adventure — a sixmonth lease at an Airbnb practically on the beach. I will always remember summer 2020 as the summer I was a full-fledged beach bum. Truly, there's nowhere I would've rather had to "stay in place" than the Belleair/Indian Rocks Beach area.

This community has become near-and-dear to my heart. True, I never thought I'd leave the Mountain West for a sub-tropical coastline. But I've dropped an anchor here in Florida and, no matter where my future travels may take me, I know I'll always come drifting back.
