



the great outdoors tips for living inside-out

1. This is the space where you can create an area to entertain, throw parties, and even have weddings. Use it wisely when creating the floor plan. Think of outside seating to watch the big game, cafe tables for outdoor dining, or a large dining table for the dinner party. Are there areas that can be cleaned up to create more space? How would you like to use your outdoor living room? Create space for games, cornhole, or miniature golf.

- 2. Consider where the sun shines and when. If the only space for the living room is in an open area with bright sunlight, consider building a cabana adorned with outdoor drapery fabric that is "sun-sational," weather-resistant, and protects from bugs and harmful UV rays! Also available are solar shades that can be installed outdoors.
- 3. No place for the TV? A custom weather-resistant TV cabinet just might be the answer.
- 4. Remember, not all outdoor furniture is alike. Look for aluminum framing to ensure the resistance of rusting, and outdoor weatherproof cushions and fabric. So Simple and Incredibly Delicious

WE USUALLY LIKE TO USE RESIDENT RECIPES FOR THIS SECTION. BUT THIS SOUNDED TOO GOOD TO PASS UP AS A ST. PATRICK'S DAY ALTERNATIVE TO THE USUAL CORNED BEEF AND CABBAGE.

5 slices seeded Jewish rye bread (or rye bread of your choice) 3/4 lb. very thinly sliced, almost shaved, corned beef

1, 14.5-oz can sauerkraut, well drained

1 teaspoon caraway seeds

3/4 lb. Swiss cheese, shredded

1/2 c. milk (I used skimmed)

1 c. Thousand Island salad dressing

1 tsp. fresh ground pepper

1/4 c. heavy cream 1/3 c. prepared yellow mustard

Preheat oven to 350F. Coat an 8x8-inch casserole dish with cooking spray. Cut three pieces of the bread into 1-inch cubes and line the bottom of the dish with them. Place half of the corned beef over the cubed bread and lightly press down the layers as you go. Spread the sauerkraut evenly over the corned beef and then top with half of the shredded cheese. Evenly sprinkle the cheese with the caraway seeds. Evenly spread the remaining corned beef over the previous layers and finish with the remaining cheese.

In a small bowl whisk the eggs, milk, cream, Thousand Island dressing, mustard and ground pepper until fully mixed. Pour the egg mixture over the casserole and allow it to sit and sink in for 10 minutes.

Finely dice the remaining two slices of bread and spread it over the casserole.

Bake for 60 minutes, until the top is golden brown and the casserole is set in the middle. Check the casserole after 45 minutes and if the bread crumbs are beginning to get too dark, lightly tent the casserole with aluminum foil during the last 15 minutes of cooking. Once the casserole is fully cooked, remove from the oven and allow it to rest for 15 minutes before cutting and serving.

Chris Scott, Owner, tells his story

HBL: Where did you grow up?

SC: I was born in San Antonio, Texas. I grew up in the Dallas area. Growing up a Texan has had a huge impact on the person I am now, and the way I run the Belleair Market. You can't escape the huge sense of State and community pride in Texas. I try to bring that same attitude to our neighborhood. I think we live in a great community. The people that live around here are friendly, caring and generous. I am proud to be a part of this community!

HBL: How long have you lived in this area?

SC: I moved to Tampa in 1985 while I was in high school. I went on to the University of South Florida and graduated with a degree in business management. I have been in the Belleair area since 1997.

HBL: Tell us about your family.

SC: I have three wonderful children. My son, **Sevy**, is a junior at CCC. My daughter, **Lola**, is a freshman at CCC, and my youngest is **Tessa**. She is in 6th grade at St. Cecelia. You can find my kids hanging out at the Market from time to time, doing homework or enjoying some ice cream or Cuban sandwiches. My mom,









Mary, helps me run the store, and really enhances our family atmosphere. Julie Champion, a part owner in the business, heads up our catering and marketing. She has three children, Kayla, 19, Austin, 16 and Riley, 13. Kayla and Austin have both worked for the Belleair Market, which has led to us hiring other teenagers to work for us part-time. We have had eight different high school students employed with us just in the past year. I am

extremely proud of our record of giving local kids their first jobs, and I now have a waiting list of 15-year-olds waiting to turn 16, so they can apply.

HBL: What led up to you starting your business?

SC: I was in the wine and cigar retail business for 18 years and was looking to open a new shop in my neighborhood. A fraternity brother of mine at USF, **Bruce Van Fleet**, who

lives in Tampa, shared the same vision that I had. We wanted to take a run-down, nearly out of business convenience store with a long local history (1971) and bring it back to life. We saw a true neighborhood "**corner store**," with ice cream and candy and sandwiches and soda pop. But we wanted to add to that a walk-in cigar humidor, an exquisite wine selection and a selection of over 400 craft beers. We pulled together to make this vision a reality. I could not have asked for a better partner and friend than Bruce!

HBL: What is unique about your business? What sets you apart from the rest?

SC: The way we treat people...We truly make our customers; our employees and our neighbors feel like a family. It sounds corny, but we really do strive to know each of our customers by name. When you pull up in our parking lot, you will notice that Julie has painted inspirational messages on each of our parking bumpers. She also has painted an American flag on a gate that was blown down by the hurricane. We mounted it in our front window and have military photos from our customers honoring those who protect our nation. We encourage anyone with family or friends who are in the military or are veterans to give us a picture we can add to our flag. Whether it is a loaf of bread, a case of wine or a 300 person-catering event, we go above and beyond what is expected of us to make our customers happy.

HBL: Given your business expertise, what advice can you offer to your residents?

SC: I have three pieces of advice to share...

- 1. You don't have to overpay for wine. I have worked for 23 years finding reasonably priced wines that exceed your expectations.
