



They got married in 2010 after Asher had just finished his first deployment to Afghanistan. They have been stationed all around the U.S. and outside the continental United States. They have lived in Fort Knox, KY, Fort Drum, NY, Fort Benning, GA, Pearl Harbor, HI, Schofield Barracks, HI, and their





final stop was being stationed down here in their hometown area.

"While still living in Hawaii, we had our parents view our current home for us. We knew we loved the neighborhood and upon their recommendation, we purchased the house sight on seen. It wasn't until almost six months later that we saw our home with our own eyes." They took the next two years to fully renovate the entire house while living with Jessica's parents at their home in Clearwater. 
Shortly after returning from Afghanistan in 2010, Asher went back to Afghanistan and multiple other middle eastern coun-

The facility will be small, 14 beds max, and they want it, most of all, to feel like a home-away-from-home for their future residents.



Enhance the (Small) Space



The Challenge:

Our client's remodeling project included removing a staircase in one area of the home and installing a floating staircase and glass elevator in another area. The challenge? What to do with the area where the prior staircase was removed.

The Enhanced Space:

My vision was to create an alcove that would give a "WOW" feeling as soon as you walked through the front door. I designed a light fixture made of blown-glass plates with track lighting. On the window, we installed one of my favorites—a motorized Hunter Douglas Silhouette®—which is a "WOW" in its own right. I used the same purple fabric from a chair in our Vanguard line on the simple, contemporary cornice. Choosing glass plates to cascade down the wall draws the eye directly into the space. For my finishing touches, we added custom throw pillows and lucite side tables. It is always an exciting moment when a small space puts a BIG smile on everyone's face!
