Professions:

Yvonne runs a busy web design and marketing business, Consultel, Inc., that she founded in 1997 (see her ads in our monthly HB Living). She and her team create unique logo designs, custom websites, social media accounts, and paid online advertising. They specialize in SEO (search engine optimization) and SEM (search engine marketing) - helping their clients' websites to be easily found on the internet.

"Some of our clients have been with us since I started the company, over 20 years ago," Yvonne said. "We have redesigned some sites six different times; keeping their sites current with the trends and advanced technology."

Yvonne graduated from New Mexico State University with a BA in journalism and media studies. She spent her early years working in San Diego, California with a magazine, a national telecommunications company, and later worked with the largest billboard / special events company in Atlanta, Georgia, prior to starting her own business.



Terry is a seasoned entrepreneur and eCommerce expert. He currently operates an eCommerce company that sells products worldwide on Amazon to consumers and business customers. 
Vacation Destination:

We have often wondered if video gaming is a sport. HBL met a 14-year-old gamer from Live Oak Lane who explained that gaming is called an ESport. His name is David Cruze Jr. and he is a freshman at Largo High School. He offered information that gaming is extremely competitive, takes intense eye/hand coordination, requires a lot of energy and can get your heart rate up.





Pumpkin Maple Pie

PUMPKIN MAPLE PIE, OH MY!

Perfect Thanksgiving Dessert

Crust:

2 Cups Flour 2/3 + 2 Tablespoons Shortening 5-6 Tablespoons Water

Measure flour and cut in the shortening. Add water to the right consistency.

Roll thin and line pie pan. (Save a small ball for the leaves on top.)

Mix the filling:

For Regular-size Pie Pan

- 2 Cups Canned Pumpkin (16 oz can)
- 1 1/4 Cups Whipping Cream
- ¾ Cups Real Maple Syrup
- 3 Eggs
- · 1 Tablespoon Cointreau
- · 1 teaspoon Vanilla
- ½ teaspoon each Allspice, Nutmeg and Ginger

For a deep-dish pie pan, use 32 oz pumpkin and double all of the other ingredients.



Bake 350° for 40 minutes.

While pie is baking, make leaves for the top:

Roll thin the ball of pie crust. Using a dried maple leaf, outline the Wleaves (Make 3). Scar the lines within the leaf, and rub lightly with cinnamon.

Place leaves on top of pie filling with the base of the leaves working from the center. About 10 mins before it's finished baking add the leaves on top.

Bake 350 for an additional 10 minutes.




Cierra just started her college studies to further her musical career and plans to work towards becoming a performer while earning a degree in music education!





Is there any Advantage to Using 1-800 Services to Place Your Flower Orders? **ABSOLUTELY NOT...SHOP LOCAL FOR BEST SERVICE, PRODUCTS AND PRICES!**

Is there any advantage to using 1-800 services or national marketing websites, to place flower orders?

Absolutely not. It makes no sense to involve a middleman in your very personal flower order when long-distance phone charges are ancient history and virtually all florists have their own websites.

Most consumers placing orders with a 1-800 service or a floral internet marketing company, have no idea that this middleman is going to turn around and forward (fax) their order to a local florist and then keep almost 30% of the order's value, or, in some cases, much more. Be assured you are doing business with a fax machine with nary a flower in sight.

Also, remember, if you do place an order with one of these companies and you have a problem with the quality or delivery of your order, you will not be able to talk to the owner, designer, or delivery person at the florist who actually filled the order. You will speak with someone in a service center (most often in a foreign country) who then has to try to contact the florist that filled your order and... you get the picture. Very frustrating.

So how do you avoid the headaches?

Always go online and search for a local florist close to your recipient — this will keep your delivery

cost down. Read the reviews on that website — this assures that the reviewer actually did business with that florist. And lastly, know that the stock photos on a florist's website are not your only choices; you can request any flower and stem count you want!





1 C BROWN SUGAR
1 T CORNSTARCH
1 EGG, BEATEN
1 C EVAPORATED MILK

1 T GROUND CINNAMON 1/4 T GROUND ALLSPICE 1/4 T GROUND CLOVES

1/4 T GROUND CLOVES 1/4 T GROUND GINGER

1/4 T NUTMEG 1 (9 INCH) UNBAKED PIE SHELL

Place squash in saucepan with enough water to cover.

Bring to a boil and simmer over medium heat until tender, about 15 minutes.

Drain and cool.

Heat oven to 350 degrees


In a blender or food processor, combine squash, brown sugar, cornstarch, egg,milk, cinnamon, allspice, cloves, ginger and nutmeg.

JH: Their delightful personalities and "doggish" ways keep us company and will always be with us, even after they're gone.




