

Booking a cruise to Alaska can be very overwhelming and confusing. There are many cruise lines, itineraries, ships, seasons, and prices. Harbor Bluffs residents Kelly, Sean, and Riley Woodruff and their extended family traveled on a cruise to Alaska last August and were simply overwhelmed by the beauty and diversity of this great state. So, how do you start planning an Alaskan cruise? Here are a few questions to ask yourself:

When do I want to visit?

Most cruise lines operate in Alaska mid-May to mid-September.











If you plan a pre- or post- stop in Denali, which is open yearround, keep in mind that lodges and tours are only offered mid-June to end of August.

Who do you want to travel with?

Will it be a family trip? Kids love cruises. All the major cruise ship lines cater to children, with multiple pools, activities, bunk beds, free ice cream, babysitting services, and plenty of G-rated entertainment. Many even have heated pools inside.

Trying to avoid children? Cruise before June or after mid-August, when kids will still -or again - be in school, or seek out the adults-only areas on the cruise ship. Kelly and Sean's cruise was a multi-generational cruise for them, so it was important to have activities and quiet time for all the different ages.

Dozens of cruise ships sail the Inside Passage every summer. Most go to Ketchikan, Juneau, Skagway, and either Glacier Bay National Park or Tracy Arm Fjord. And many cruises leave from Seattle or Vancouver and Delta has nonstop flights from Tampa. But ask yourself what it is you want to do and see? Travel to the top of Mount White Pass, it follows the same trail route taken in the late 19th century by a steady stream of gold prospectors - only they did it on foot. Or, if you are not quite that adventurous, visit the Alaskan Sea Life Center or one of the many native villages nestled along the route. Kelly and Sean rented a car one day in port and went all the way to the Yukon. In another port, they went out on a boat to go deep-

sea salmon fishing and had their catch shipped home on ice. The possibilities are endless!

Filling

Combine cream cheese with powdered sugar. Use the grater to extract lemon peel (try to avoid the pith as it will make your filling bitter). Add your rind to cream cheese and then add 1 cup of heavy cream. Once combined blend away until whipped thoroughly with no lumps.

Breading

First, you will need to process your pecans finely and then add the cinnamon to your processed pecans and mix with a whisk.

Batter

Whisk your eggs thoroughly and combine 1-cup heavy cream and 1-tablespoon cinnamon.

Take your brioche baguettes and cut them approximately 6" and butterfly your bread. Open up your baguettes and add your lemon cream cheese filling evenly and place the filling in the center of your brioche and add as many blueberries as you like. Once this is achieved close up your brioche baguettes, you will then dip them in the batter and dust with pecan breading on both sides. When you are finished place French toast in the fryer for approximately 3-4 minutes at 350° and voila! This French toast is very complementary with strawberries, raspberries, and whipped cream.

Proceeds Purchase Medical, Dental, and Vision Supplies

The Anona Thrift Shoppe (ATS) operated by Hands Of Healing, Inc., is now open and is located at 12025 Indian Rocks Road in Harbor Crest Shopping Center, across from Publix in Largo. All proceeds from this thrift store will help purchase medical, dental, and vision supplies for future medical missions.

The thrift store was the brain-child of four women who serve on the Hands Of Healing Board of Directors: Carolyn Fishback, Nancy Dowd, Betsy Bomar, and Cindi Thomas, a resident of Harbor Bluffs from Harbor View Lane.

HBL asked Cindi, "Why open a thrift store?" She said, "We needed a fresh and creative way to con-















tinue to fundraise for future medical mission trips. Our medical supplies run about \$30,000 per trip." Volunteers on the mission trip pay their own expenses.

At one of the group's board meetings in early 2019, they discussed how to raise funds for the 2020 medical mission trip. Carolyn and Nancy, who volunteer at other local non-profit thrift stores, brought up the idea of opening a thrift store. The board agreed to establish a committee and began the due diligence process. It took six months and many hours of research to get their questions answered, find a location, and establish a volunteer base.

Since its opening in late September 2019, the store has gotten great reviews. It looks and feels more like a boutique than a thrift store. The prices are very reasonable (\$2-\$5 for women's and men's shirts, \$6 for nice dresses, and shoes \$4) and the quality and style are top-shelf. Also, a difference from other thrift stores is that ATS carries men's clothing with brand names such as Polo, Ralph Lauren, and Tommy Bahama. There is also a women's "designer section," with brands that include Chico's, J Crew, Lilly Pulitzer, Michael Kors, Coach, Ralph Lauren, and Kate Spade. And it changes daily!

You can also find several stylish, and sometimes new, home décor items, small furniture pieces, lamps, nice linens, china, fine glassware, and art.

Nancy told *HBL* that the success of the store has really been exciting because "the store is living up to our motto of Reuse-Reduce-Recycle and Repurpose." Since the opening, ATS has teamed up and donated to organizations that include Clothes For Kids, Habitat for Humanity, Metropolitan Min-

istries, Lealman Project, New2U,

Vietnam Veterans, My Place for Recovery, and St. Joseph Children's Hospital, just to mention a few.

"Everything we take in that isn't put out in the store gets re-purposed or donated," Nancy said. "And, of course, we love the compliments about the store looking like a boutique."

But you can't really talk about Anona Thrift Shoppe without talking about its owners, Hands Of Healing, Inc. (HOH), a faith-based organization established in early 2000, in which all faiths participate. The organization was ignited by a spark after two of its member families adopted children from Guatemala. In addition, one of the members hosted an exchange student, who became like a daughter. That young woman is now a board-certified

ENT surgeon back in her birth country

of Guatemala. This combination of personal interests began

a search for a special heartfelt mission within Central America.

HOH is a stand-alone 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that launched out of the Anona United Methodist Church. "The church supports our mission efforts and the congregation has

poured out its heart in donations and volunteers," Nancy said. "The surrounding commu-

nities have also graciously supported this endeavor as many of the practitioners that travel with us are from the area."

Most of the medical mission trips are to remote areas of Guatemala. People ask why Guatemala? "This country has the largest malnutrition rate in Latin American and is considered one of the most malnourished countries in the world, especially women and children. Over 80 percent of the indigenous people have no access to medical care or social service," said Nancy.

Teams of doctors, nurses, paramedics, dentists, a vision specialist and a variety of other volunteers have provided health, vision and dental care to thousands of impoverished people in Guatemala.

Anona Thrift Shoppe was formed to help this community do their part to recycle on many levels. With the piles of no-longer-wanted items making their way to the dumps, it's nice to

see retailers like Levi Strauss,

North Face, H & M and Penny's getting in on the recycling trend. Let's do our part...



Thomas Gurganus, a Pittsburgh, PA, native ... and father to two amazing girls, Dani, 15, and Alayna, 18 ... found himself on a unique journey that landed him here — at the beaches of the Gulf coast.



SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO DIET

medical minute

How many of you have made a New Year's resolution to diet and lose weight, start exercising, or both? Each one is a great idea, but the concept of diet should no longer mean restricting calories to lose weight. Try to think of your diet as a new habit and way of life.

There are so many diets out there that promote weight loss but most are unsustainable. Trending now is the keto diet and intermittent fasting. But I propose that if you eat the Mediterranean diet that you will never have to diet. The Mediterranean diet has been shown to reduce the risk of heart disease (number one killer of both men and women), breast cancer, and colon cancer (number three cancer in men and women). Don't we diet to be healthy and live longer?

There is no one definition of the Mediterranean diet, but the most common description is a diet that consists of fruits and vegetables, olive oil as the source of fat and three servings of fish a week. Dairy and any other meat are consumed sparingly.

To better understand the importance of a clean diet, The Blue Zones project TED Talk is my favorite! Dan Buettner founded Blue Zones to research the world's best practices in health and longevity. Listening to his TED Talk is a quick and easy way to get all the essential information that is in the book. He set out to find the secrets of the world's longest-lived people.

Interestingly, there is a group of people in Linda Loma, CA, that live 10 years longer than the average American. I have to admit that I was surprised! Once I learned their eating habits, it made sense. They also had daily exercise through their work. These people, living just outside of Los Angeles, belong to the Adventists religion. Conservative Seventh Day Adventists take the Bible literally and the scripture says that God gave nuts, grains, and herbs as nourishment. Therefore, they eat a plant-based diet, similar to the Mediterranean diet.

Now, I don't think everyone has to become a vegetarian. When you consider the Mediterranean diet, your goals should be to consume five vegetables a day and limit processed foods. If you want to eat meat, don't eat the processed meats (lunch meat, bacon, sausages, hot dogs, smoked meats) but focus on free-range meats and eggs. Eat whole grains: brown rice, 100 percent whole wheat bread, steel-cut oats, and quinoa. Legumes (lentils) and beans are great sources of protein. Raw nuts (walnuts and almonds) make a great snack! I try to think about what nutrients each food supplies when I eat something and what benefits I get from each food. Eat to live = the Mediterranean diet!
