



The sweetness of dessert has existed long before there was a proper title for it. As an act of worship, ancient civilizations would offer dried fruits and honey to their gods.

In Ancient Greece, a special sweet bread was made with nuts and honey to make an almost cake-like dish called plakous.

Ingredients to make Plakous

- 1. {Make ready 250 gm of whole wheat.
- 2. {Prepare 100 gm of butter.
- 3. {Get 60 gm of sugar.
- 4. {Get 1 tsp of vanilla essence.
- 5. {Get 1 tsp of baking soda.
- 6. {Take 1 tsp of baking powder.
- 7. {Make ready 100 gm of milkmaid.
- 8. {Make ready 1.5 lt of hot milk.
- 9. {Prepare of For decoration:.
- 10. {Make ready 1 cup of butter.
- 11. $\{Prepare 2, 1/2 + 1/3 \text{ cups of granulated sugar.}\}$
- 12. {Make ready 1 tablespoon of all-purpose flour.
- 13. {Prepare 1 cup of heavy cream.
- 14. {Prepare 1 teaspoon of vanilla extract.
- 15. {Get As needed of white Choco chip.
- 16. {Make ready As needed of kiwi black and green grapes.

Instructions to make Plakous - Greek cake:

- 1. Take sugar and butter beat till fluffy add milkmaid beat again.
- 2. Add flour vanilla extract baking powder baking soda and mix well.
- 3. Slowly add milk and batter is ready.
- 4. Put batter in greased cake tin and put in preheated oven for 40 to 45 min.
- 5. For decoration: Place sugar in pan Cook over medium-high heat, stirring constantly, until the sugar turns to a golden-brown liquid. The sugar will clump at first, but continue to stir and it will eventually melt and begin to brown. Remove from the heat.
- 6. Add the remaining sugar, flour, and cream. Whisk until smooth.
- 7. Return the pan to medium-high heat. Cook, stirring occasionally, about 12 minutes. Remove from the heat. Stir in butter and vanilla. Cool the mixture about 1 hour.
- 8. After properly cool down. Add Remaining butter and mix it with hand mixer.
- 9. It's time to apply caramel. Cut layers of cake and apply caramel. Then spread caramel on top of layers carefully with help of wide and long knife. Decorate with kiwi and grapes apply some Choco chips in center.



Cruise Lines are **Enforcing all Precautions** Against COVID

Early August I was honored to be invited to sail on the Norwegian Gem on the first test cruise out of Miami.

All passengers had to be vaccinated and upload their vaccination cards into the Norwegian portal and we were advised that additional testing was to be done at the pier. In order to be eligible for the free testing, we had to register with My CVS Health and they had all our data available.

On departure day we had an early boarding time of 9:30 am. When we arrived at the pier, masked up, there were no lines and plenty of staff guiding us through the different stations.

Pandemic.

First, we went through a metal detector, then stepped up to a registration desk and had our temperatures taken, then were assigned a testing station. There were about 20 stations

and no wait, no lines. And was almost eerily quiet and each and every staff member was so friendly. The test was a self-administered nasal swab, not my favorite, and we were watched closely while swirling that cotton swab inside our nasal cavities.

We were given a number and asked to sit, socially distanced, for about 10 minutes while our samples were tested. After 11 minutes one of the nurses came to us and swiped our bar code and we were good to go.

The next station was at TSA inside the terminal. It took all of 60 seconds and again, no lines, no wait. Off we went to the registration desk, got our passports checked and boarding passes scanned and were pointed to the next station, where we picked up our key cards.

From the time we stepped into the terminal to the minute we stepped on board maybe a total of 25 minutes had elapsed. The Norwegian Gem is the 6th and final ship in Norwegian's Jewell Class and can carry a total of 2,400 passengers.

We had to be masked during the boarding process but were allowed to remove masks once on board. All staff has to wear masks when interacting with passengers and masks were encouraged amongst passengers when moving about but not mandated. As we found out later that first day, only 600 travel advisors were invited to sail for the inaugural test cruise, explaining the non-existing lines and plentiful staff.



It probably was one of the best cruises I have ever been on! Norwegian had a full staff of almost 1,100 members on board. That is a 2 to 1 ratio and they made us feel like royalty. Everything was open, all specialty restaurants, spa, all bars, there were several comedy shows a day, an art auction, the nightly entertainment, full casino, and shops.

All staff was ecstatic to see us. There wasn't a single face throughout the cruise that didn't have a big grin, we were greeted and catered to every minute of the day. The staff made our cruise and made this sailing so memorable. You could feel their joy of being back to work and when we sailed out of the port in Miami, hundreds of spectators had lined up by the pier and were cheering clapping for Norwegian's return to cruising. I don't think I have ever been on a cruise that wasn't fully booked and now I am spoiled for life! We strolled to the pool in the morning and there



are plenty of loungers. We walked into the theater five minutes before showtime and had our pick of seats. Sitting by the window

in the main dining room? No problem. Our balcony cabin was spotless and our steward came twice a day to freshen up our room, replenish towels, and to make sure we had everything we could possibly need. He didn't have to do that, of course, but he said he was just happy to be working again.

We had one stop in Nassau and booked an excursion to The Blue Lagoon. The Bahamians are very serious about safety protocols and masks were mandated during our transfer and while walking to the beach on Blue Lagoon Island.

Once we were seated, the masks could come off but had to be worn while in line to get something to eat or drink. If you ever have been to the Bahamas, you know it is the most beautiful water in the world. My group of friends had brought floaties and the only time we left the water was to eat or to get a drink.

Again, plenty of space to socially distance and the weather was perfect. I was impressed with Norwegian's thorough protocols and safety measures. There are different opinions on the safety of cruising and I respect everybody's feelings. If and when you feel you are ready, I am here and I'd be happy to guide you towards the best and safest cruise for you.

Although each hurricane is different, the wind speeds brought with them can a very specific. As such, the damages brought with these wind speeds tend to be similar. Here is what you can expect with each category wind speed:

Cat. 1: *74-95 mph winds* --> some missing shingles with minimal tree debris

Cat. 2: 96--110 mph winds --> increase missing shingles, flying debris which can damage windows, broken siding, fallen and leaning trees

Cat 3: 111-129 mph winds --> blown-in windows, lifting of roofs, smaller fallen trees

Cat 4: 130-156 mph winds--> large flying debris, mostly shingles missing, most shingles fallen, extreme interior flooding from rain intrusions

Cat 5: *157+ mph winds* --> catastrophic damage to the structure of the home

It is important to protect yourself in the event of any of the category hurricanes noted above. As such, each individual should take the following precautions:


- 1. Make sure all exterior furniture, tools, and or toys are stored indoors and/or tightly tied down.
- 2. If possible, trim trees and large shrubs back to avoid damage to your property.
- 3. In the event of a major hurricane (Category 3 or above) make sure you have secured your home. This can include boarding up windows and placing sandbags around the exterior doors.
- 4. If you choose to ride out the storm, make sure you have plenty of potable water and adequate lighting should the power go out.
- 5. During the passing of the storm head to the interior room of the property where it is the safest. Make sure to stay away from all exterior windows and/or doors.
- 6. Do not leave the house until the storm has passed. At which point, proceed with caution as there may be downed power lines and or ruptured gas lines.
- 7. Use common sense and your best judgment. Staying safe is the key.

How to protect your potential insurance claim prior to a hurricane:

- 1. Make a complete list of all the contents in your home.
- 2. Make sure all areas of repair needed to the property are done prior to the hurricane passing.
- 3. Document the home before the storm comes. Personally, my wife and I do a video walkthrough of the home to have a record of the condition of the property prior to the loss.
- 4. Notify your carrier immediately or as soon as possible of the potential damage to your home and/or personal property.
- 5. Ask your carrier questions. Carriers are in the business of making money.
- 6. Obtain a second opinion on your carrier's estimate.
