Your name: Riley Champion

What organization do you volunteer with? Moffitt Cancer Center

How long have you been volunteering with this organization? Since September 2018.



**HBL:** What types of tasks do you perform for this group? **RC:** I decided to make pink ornaments during Christmastime and sold them at the Belleair Market on a miniature Christmas tree that I decorated in pink. I used the money that I raised to make baskets for the patients. I was able to get a list of items that were needed (lip balms, socks, Kleenex, crossword puzzles, etc.) and put them in each basket.

HBL: Wow what a kind-hearted girl you are!!

**HBL:** How many hours a week on average do you spend volunteering?

RC: I hadn't done that much in the past until I did this project, but it has made me want to do more for people, whatever is needed.

HBL: How can others get involved with this organization?RC: Just call Moffitt and ask if there is anything you can do to help. If nothing else, you can always drop off some of the items they have on their list.





HBL: Why did you choose this project or what drew you to volunteer for this organization?
RC: Actually, my mom had cancer about seven years ago and she had

to go through chemo and radiation. She told me how she remembered when she would go for the chemo treatments, a lady knitted hats and blankets for the patients, and she thought that was so nice. She says that it's always cold in the rooms so I thought a little basket of goodies would be a neat idea. I was just going to raise money and give it to Moffitt but I then decided to make the baskets instead. Moffitt probably gets a lot of money for research but not as much for the patients.

**HBL:** What benefits do you get from volunteering with this organization?

RC: Just knowing that I could help someone else who is going through a major health scare in their life, even if it's just a little something, makes me feel good. Luckily, my mom had our family to support her, but there are some people who have to do this alone and hopefully seeing one of my baskets will make them feel like there is someone out there who cares.

**HBL:** How long have you lived in the neighborhood? What made you move to the neighborhood? What is your favorite part of living in the neighborhood?

RC: I have lived in my neighborhood my entire life (14 years). My family moved in before I was born. I love my neighbors, and growing up with my best friend that used to live down the street was fun.

HBL: It has been such a pleasure to feature you, Riley. You are a true inspiration to young adults in making a difference in this world. We can't wait to follow your entire story through high school!



#### 1. LUGGAGE AND PACKING

Lay out everything you think you need, then put half of it back. Trust me on this, you still will have packed too much and you do want to leave some room for souvenirs.

Pack an extra set of clothes in your carry-on bag. Don't be one of those travelers missing out on all the fun because the airline lost your luggage and you have nothing else to wear.

To check a bag or not to check a bag? Each airline has its own set of guidelines as to what can be checked or carried on for free. Make sure to look up what your airline's rules are to avoid any surprise fee.

#### 2. SECURITY AND HEALTH

Check-in with your doctor and insurance carrier. Double-check and make sure that you have all of the proper vaccinations and that you have renewed all essential prescriptions. Also, ask your medical insurance provider if your policy applies overseas for emergencies. Most insurance companies don't extend coverage in foreign countries, supplemental travel insurance that covers medical emergencies, as well as transportation home, is essential

Bring copies of your passport. If your passport gets stolen or lost you want to be sure that you can still get back into the country, or be able to prove your citizenship. If you book with a travel agent, most will encourage you to upload all your travel documents to a

secure website so you have access to it in case of emergency.

Check the US Department of State website, https://
travel.state.gov/content/
travel.html, for current travel advisories and warnings.

#### 3. MONEY

Look up the monetary conversion before you go. Finding out that one Danish Krone is equal to just 19 cents ... bad surprise. Do your math before you travel to get a sense of where the conversion rate is at.

Make sure your credit card will work in the country you're visiting. European banks have switched almost completely to the more secure chip-and-PIN technology, and fewer businesses abroad are accepting the outdated magnetic-strip cards. American Express is not widely accepted, especially in Europe and many store and shops will only accept Visa or Mastercard.

Go to a bank or ATM in the country you're visiting. The conversion centers in the airport or around the city tend to be huge ripoffs. You won't get charged as many fees at the ATM or the bank, and the conversion will be exact.

Always have local cash. Not every place takes credit cards. Especially important places like trains or buses.

Call your bank and credit card provider. Sometimes banks think that fraud may be occurring if transactions are suddenly happening in Bali when you're from Jersey, and they will turn off your card as a security measure. Always carry a second credit card with you.

#### 4. **ELECTRONICS**

Bring an adapter. Countries have different size plugs and voltage. So if you want to use your iPod, make sure you can charge it. A power strip can be a way to cheat and charge multiple devices off of one adapter.

Check the voltage of your electronics. Many smaller electronic devices have dual voltage and can be used with a simple adapter, but larger electronics might need a voltage converter. I traveled with a nebulizer and almost set the hotel room on fire because it didn't convert to local voltage.

Call your phone company before you leave. WhatsApp is very popular in Europe and you might get away with just using data. Keep in mind that you will be charged for calls made and received while outside the U.S. whether you answer them or not. If you happen to be on a cruise, the charge could be as high as \$5.99 a minute, that overcharge is easily avoidable if you block all calls.

#### 5. RELAX, SLOW DOWN AND GO WITH THE FLOW

Things will go wrong, but it shouldn't ruin your vacation if you are prepared. Be sure to make time to really take in your surroundings, recharge and leave all your stress and obligations behind. It is your vacation, after all!
